3rd German-Chinese Symposium on Elderly Care

On December 9 and 10, the Bremen Health Campus and Dalian University (China) will host the 3rd German-Chinese Symposium on Elderly Care digitally via Zoom Conference. In cooperation between the Confucius Institute Bremen, RECOM GmbH (Thieme Group), the Integrated Health Campus Bremen (IGB) and Dalian University, an interesting program from both countries has been put together. The participation is free of charge. Even though China and Germany are located in different parts of Asia and Europe, both countries face serious demographic challenges.

The theme of the symposium is "Sharing experiences, promoting innovation, improving quality". Experts from China and Germany from the fields of elderly care policy, education, practice, management and research are invited. A bi-national platform is offered, as it is worthwhile for both countries to share and learn from each other in terms of policy development, education, research and nursing practice in geriatrics and elderly care.

During the conference there will be simultaneous interpretation between the Chinese and German speakers.

Day 1 will be held in German and simultaneously in Chinese.

Day 2 will be held in English.

The Integrated Health Campus Bremen (IGB) has existed since 2021 and was initiated by the Senator for Science and Ports in cooperation with the Senator for Health, Women's Affairs and Consumer Protection.

Today, the IGB sees itself as a strategic and creative bracket for a network of players from the fields of health research, health economy, health care as well as healthcare and nursing professions (4H). With this strong network structure of currently 46 network partners (gesundheitscampusbremen.de), Bremen's regional potential in these areas must be illustrated. ENP is available both as a book publication and as a database for the integration into RECOM-GRIPS as well as an external database in third-party systems.

ENP is registered as an official instrument for the clear telematic data exchange at the German Institute for Medical Documentation and Information with the OID 1.2.276.0.76.5.515. In addition, ENP is the first nursing classification to be included in the German Gematik Directory.

Dalian University

Dalian University, named after the city, is a higher education institution born with the founding of New China. Over the past 70 years, the university has inherited red genes and continuously adhered to its original mission of educating people for the Party and the country. Based on the urgent need for talents for Dalian's reform and opening up as well as economic and social development, the university has developed and grown through interaction with the city, and now it has developed into a university with complete disciplines in the province. School of Nursing

Nursing education at Dalian University can be traced back to the founding of the Dalian Health School in 1950. In 2000, it enrolled nursing undergraduates; in 2011, it became one of the national nursing academic master's degree authorizations. In 2014, the School of Nursing at Dalian University was founded. In 2019, it was approved as one of the first national first-class undergraduate major construction sites.

We pay attention to scientific research and academic exchanges. We have five stable research directions: rehabilitation nursing, geriatric care and elderly service, chronic disease health management, emergency and critical care nursing and nursing management. We have hosted six national and international academic conferences, co-organized 3 International Nursing forums of the University of Hong Kong, organized two critical meetings of the Ministry of Education's Nursing Education Committee, hosted four training courses for nursing teachers in the country and Northeast China, and invited well-known experts in the field of higher medical education at home and abroad to give a series of 60 high-level academic lectures. We have established friendly and cooperative relations with universities in Canada, Australia, Germany, Singapore, Hong Kong and other countries and regions. In 2021, it ranked fifth in the Ranking of Chinese University Nursing, 36th in the best nursing subject in China, and the top among local universities.

Prof. Dr. med. Elmar Gräbel is a doctor and university lecturer. His habilitation subjects are medical psychology (1997) and medical sociology (2003).

His position is head of the Centre for Medical Care Research (ZMV) and head of the Department of Medical Psychology and Medical Sociology (teaching) at the Psychiatric University Hospital Erlangen. His scientific focus is on research into non-drug therapies for dementia, research into the situation of caring relatives, development and validation of psychological measurement instruments (psychometrics).

He has won numerous scientific prizes, such as : Research Promotion Prize of the German Alzheimer Society 2000 and 2002 and Theo and Friedl Schöller Prize for Geriatric Medicine 2018.

5 scientific projects (of the last 10 years):

2014 - 2017 Study leader of the project "DeTaMAKS": cluster-randomised, controlled, multicentre intervention study on MAKS-m, a multimodal, non-drug therapy for persons with mild to moderate dementia in day care with telephone-based family brief intervention.

2015 - 2018 Head of research training group for the preparation of reviews on non-pharmacological prevention, therapy and care approaches in dementia (OptiDem).

2019 - 2021 Study leader of the MAKS-s project: cluster-randomised, controlled, multicentre intervention study on MAKS-s, a multimodal, non-drug therapy for people with severe dementia in nursing homes.

Since 1/2019 Project management "Digital Dementia Register Bavaria (digiDEM)".

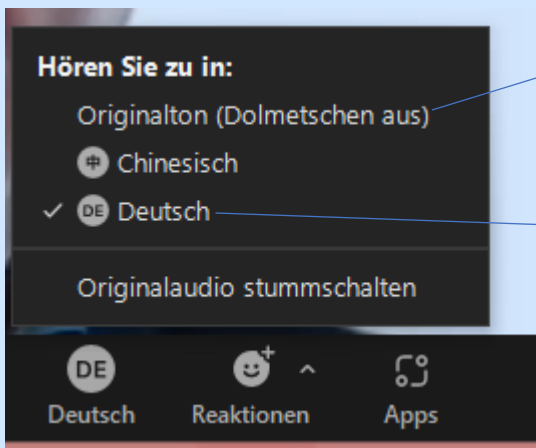
